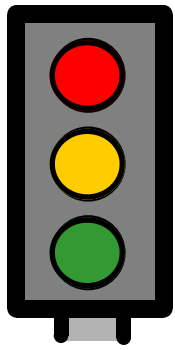
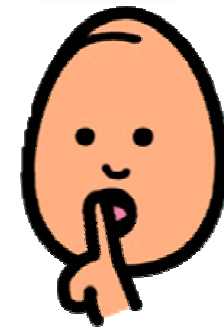

An **Advocate** is someone who is trained to support a Person's views to be heard



An **Advocacy Partner** is the Person who has support to make their views heard



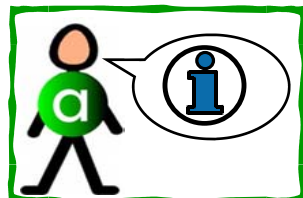
Advocacy believes that the Advocacy Partners voice and views are important



Advocacy is based on **Confidentiality**

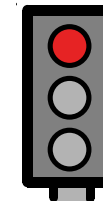


Confidentiality is about keeping it private

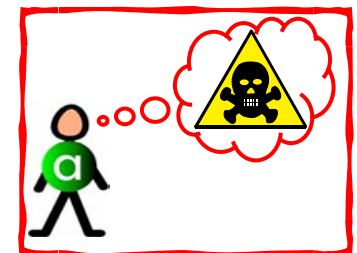


An Advocate will share your information with other people if you want it shared

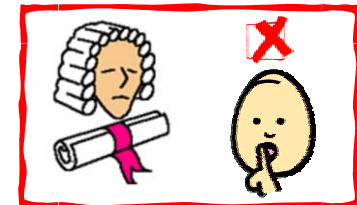
There are reasons that can make it hard for an Advocate to keep confidentiality



If the Advocate believes you or someone else is in immediate danger the Advocate may break confidentiality



If a Court of Law tells an Advocate to share your information with someone the Advocate will break confidentiality!



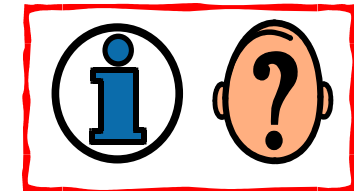
An Advocate will only break confidentiality if nothing else works!



1. Check the immediate danger



2. Check who already knows
